Purpose of the research

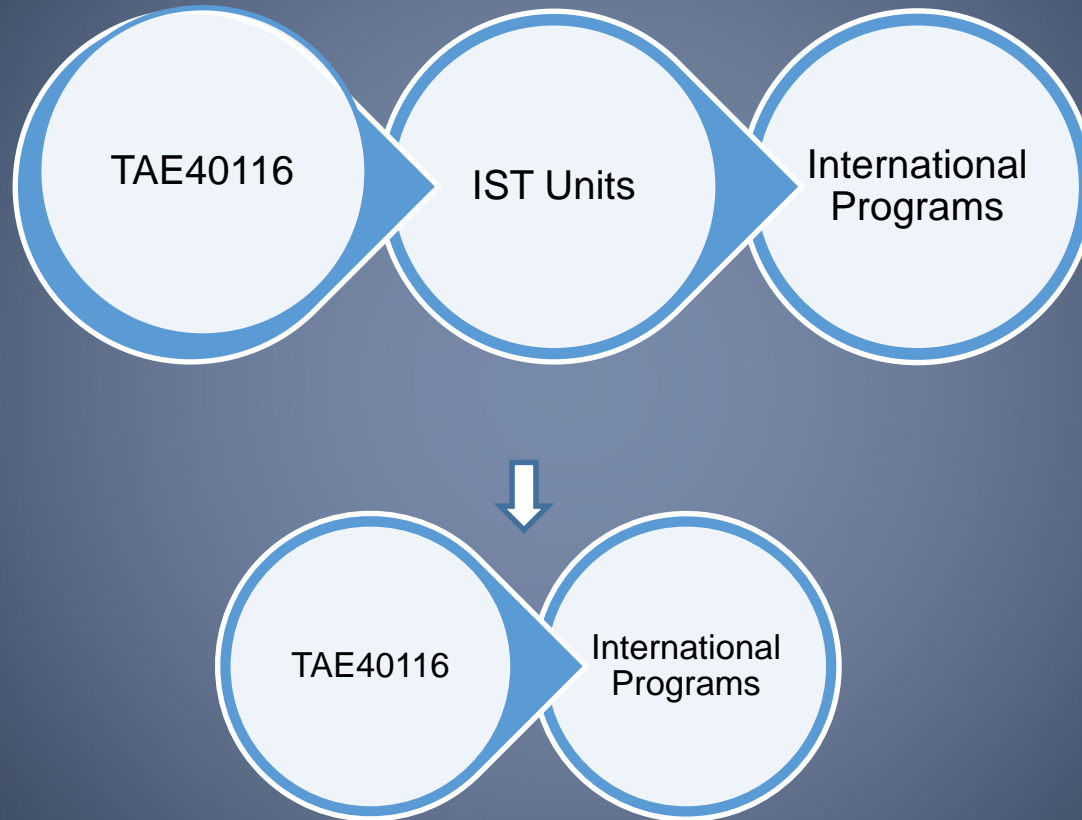
Comparative analysis

Principles of comparison

- **Principle 1-** The role and responsibilities of Australian VET authority and others
- **Principle 2-** Comparability of Australian and other VET Frameworks and their levels
- **Principle 3-** Articulation across post-secondary qualification framework
- **Principle 4-** Mutual recognition (Transparent processes, policies for the inclusion of qualifications in the VET frameworks / articulation)
- **Principle 5-** Are these frameworks underpinned by quality assurance and are consistent with international quality assurance principles
- **Principle 6-** National/Regional policies for the validation of all learning and credit systems where these exist
- **Principle 7-** The financial aspect

TVETC001- IST Trainer

TVETC002- IST Assessor

TVETC003- IST Advanced Trainer & Assessor

So far we have been able to gather VET trainer training program data from East Timor, Philippine and Sri Lanka.

2. Mapping of VET trainer preparation qualifications

Research Impact

International

1. Providing opportunity for international VET trainer preparation programs to be benchmarked against Australian TAE40116
